During this PTA-sponsored program, the student will continue to model the FLL Core Values and Oak Hill's P.A.W.S. expectations at all times during team activities and FLL tournaments.

P for Positive Attitude

- Respect the team coaches and mentors. Listen to their advice during team meetings. Address the coaches and mentors in a respectful manner when asking or responding to questions.
- Be kind and considerate to your teammates. Respect their opinions and keep an open mind. Give every teammate the opportunity to speak out and be heard. Pay attention when they are speaking. Address your teammates in a respectful manner.

A for Accountability

- Arrive at team meetings on time. Inform the coaches if you are delayed or unable to attend. Come prepared to the meeting. Bring any materials or work that is expected by the team.
- Take care of the materials provided by Oak Hill PTA. This includes all the EV3 kit, FLL table, FLL field mat and mission sets. Use the team materials only for the purposes of this FLL challenge. Take care of the materials provided by the coaches/mentors. This includes a computer and other materials that may be used for the team's research and presentation.
- Use your meeting time wisely and effectively by refraining from doing other activities that may distract you from your team's goals or FLL challenge work.

W for Willingness to Learn

- > Ask questions respectfully. Ask questions that are relevant to the FLL challenge.
- > Ask for assistance if you don't understand the concepts or need more clarification/information.
- ▶ Keep an open mind. Use your imagination and creativity to work on the FLL season challenge.
- ▶ Use all available sources of information during research and problem solving.

S for Safety

- \geq 2 adults must be present at every team meeting to oversee the student team members.
- When the team is in a public area, student must inform the adult in charge if they need to leave the team area. Team member should not leave a team area without a coach's permission. We encourage coaches to instill the "buddy system" during tournaments.
- Before leaving the meeting area, team members must make sure that all materials are put back in place and that team belongings are secure.

FLL Core Values:

- We are a team. We do the work to find solutions with guidance from our coaches and mentors.
- We honor the spirit of friendly competition. What we discover is more important than what we win.
- We share our experiences with others. We display Gracious Professionalism in everything we do.
- We have fun.

How will FLL Parent Coaches and Oak Hill PTA address behavioral concerns:

- 1. Initial offense will result in a verbal reminder from parent coaches/mentors.
- 2. Second offense, depending on behavior, may result in student being asked to "take a break" or be moved to a different task group. Coaches/mentors should inform the parents/guardians about their behavioral concerns.
- 3. Consistent offenses will result in consulting with the PTA and parent. PTA and/or coach may ask the parent to be present during the team meetings to assist in reinforcing in their child a positive behavior during team activities.
- 4. If student remains disruptive to coaches and teammates, even after the parent and PTA intervention, then the student may be asked to withdraw from the program.
